DOG FOOD: IAMS Smart Puppy, Pedigree Adult Small Bites (or Science Diet, IAMS), Purina One Lamb and Rice.

Our N.A.B.S. staff uses 350-450 lb. of dog food every week:

She continues to bring so much happiness and love into my life. I could not live without this ray of sunshine in my day.



Hi Pam. I tried to return your call last week but I don't think that I was successful with the machine!

Lyssa Lou (Alyssa) and Sergeant Pepper (Pepper) are doing very well at our house. My twins Jacob and Gracie never knew Pete when he was young and lively, so they are loving having two dogs to play with.

Pepper is still just as laid back as he can be. Just happy to be here! He loves having his hair brushed, so Gracie does lots of that! He is just right at home, no transition issues what so ever. He plays with Lyssa, but sometimes does take his spot on the end of the sofa and wants her to leave him alone. The only thing that has happened with him is that we discovered that thunder makes him nervous, so if there is a storm, he might like to get in the crate.

Lyssa is getting better, she's just an excited little girl! She reminds me of Gracie. I call them the busybodies. We got the medium crate from WalMart that you suggested. She goes in just fine. We put her in at night when its lights out time. She is getting better at calming down at night night time. On weekends we are very active outside, so she falls asleep on Pete's chair and sleeps there sometimes. I can always tell if she needs to get in, she'll walk around not able to settle. She likes to chew! The new rule around our house is that if you value it, you better put it UP! We've gotten her lots of toys, so we're working on letting her know that she has her own toys to chew on, rather than shoes, socks, etc. We've only had one more deposit in my dining room floor, so that is getting better. Poor baby does "leak" just a little when anyone comes home that she hasn't seen in a while. We're working on being calm when we come in the door, so that she doesn't get overly excited and jump on people. We've found that she feeds off of the people around her. During the day I've worked from home some, and if its just me and the dog-babies, they play, nap go out a couple of times and are very calm all day. Lyssa's excitement comes when the human babies are around, playing with her, running around the house with her, etc. She's so full of energy, we've taken your advice and she goes for Michael's run and bike ride with him.

I just look at them every day and wonder why no one would want these two precious creatures--must have been that the Lord meant for us to have them.

Oh, they LOVE the backyard. We have a wrought iron fence on the whole backside, with no neighbors. Is it called a nature reserve, they met the deer the other morning. The deer are very familiar with dogs, so they just stand there on the other side of the fence and watch the dogs bark. They love running up and down that fence, and just standing there and looking out it. There are also lots of frogs and bugs, they like to play chase with those.

I'm able to bathe them with no problem, and they don't mind having teeth brushed either. They both like hair brushing, especially Pepper. I've got appointments for them this week to take them to our vet and get their heartworm and frontline.

I'll stop now. I just wanted you to know that we're taking very good care of them. I still use a film camera, and just got some photos developed. I'll have Michael scan some and send soon.


